CUT TO:

5 EXT. FOREST WATERFALL - MORNING

HOOOOWWWLLL.

LOGAN

6 EXT. FOREST TRAIL - DAY

7 EXT. CABIN - DAY

8 INT. CABIN - DAY

8

LOGAN

9 INT. CABIN KITCHEN - DAY

LOGAN

13 INT. CABIN BEDROOM - NIGHT

LOGAN

LOGAN (CONT'D)

The soldier is finally able to make out what it is, he see's Logan sprinting towards him. He drops the radio and begins to raise his gun.

FRANTIC SOLDIER

Stop right there!

Before he can fully lift his gun up, Logan lunges into his gut. The soldier's eyes grow wide and blood rises up out of his mouth.

Logan sits on top of the soldier continuously striking the man, sending blood everywhere.

Logan is sitting at the bar, drinking and reading Hamlet.

LOGAN (V.O.)

O that this too too solid flesh would melt, Thaw and resolve itself into a dew, Or that the Everlasting had not fixed his canon 'gainst self-slaughter. O God, God, How weary, stale...

19 EXT. FOREST - DAY

19

Logan walks through the forest looking for a deer or some kind of prey to eat. *Hamlet* still plays in his head and the passage he was reading continues.

LOGAN (V.O.)

Flat and unprofitable. Seem to me all the uses of this world! Fie on't, ah fie, 'tis an unweeded garden that grows to seed, things rank and gross in nature posses it merely. That it should come to this!

Logan examines a footprint on the trail. On the trunk of a tree nearby he notices a poster, that reads: NO MUTANTS, LET'S MAKE AMERICA HUMAN AGAIN.

20 INT. CABIN BATHROOM

Playing from the speaker as Logan climbs out of the shower.

SENATOR KELLY (V.O.)

MUTANT RIGHTS ACTIVIST (V.O.) How can you call them weapons, they are no less human than you or I. They can't control the changes to their bodies any more than kid in puberty.

The soldiers death replays in Logans head.

SENATOR KELLY (V.O.)

22 INT. CABIN BATHROOM

22

LOGAN

23 EXT. FOREST - MOMENTS LATER

Ted and Bill are hanging flyers on the trees on the trail.

Further down the trail, out of the sight of Bill and Ted, Logan steps on to the trail.

Logan looks around at the forest as he walks the trail, admiring life after his failed attempt at taking his own.

On the tree next to Logan is one of the flyers that Bill and Ted are hanging up.

RIP!

Logan stares at the flyer in his hands and snarls as he reads it.

Back down the trail aways, Bill and Ted are still hanging flyers. The trees around them all have flyers on them. Ted starts to put up another one.

BILL

25 INT. CABIN KITCHEN

LOGAN (V.O.)

I still don't know what I am, but I know it's not as simple as human or monster. Maybe I'm both. Either way bub, thanks for the place to crash.

He gets up and puts the letter on the fridge door.

26 EXT. CABIN - DAY

26

A cigar rests in Logans teeth and a cowboy hat on his head.

With his commandeered belongings inside the pillow case slung over his shoulder, Logan steps off the porch and walks off into the sunset.
